The meeting also aims to review and present the latest evidence in the management of uncommon and difficult conditions, and provide a forum for discussion of these challenging cases.

Sessions include:

- Management of complications and late effects of surgical and non-surgical treatments
- Management of elderly patients with head and neck cancer
